

Prayer for the Body of Christ

General Prayer

1. Praise God for His many blessings upon your life, salvation, provision, healing, deliverance. Psalm 103:1-5
2. Thank God for His grace upon your life. Thank God for making you His workmanship, his handiwork, a special blessing to the earth. Ephesians 2:10
3. Ask God to cleanse you, create in you a clean heart and renew a right spirit within you. Psalm 51:10

1. Pray that the Lord will wake up and elevate the church to be an instrument of peace, healing and solution. Pray that God will cause a great revival to break out amongst his people, a revival like the Azusa street revival that will transform lives. 3. Pray that God will cause believers all across the globe to be salt and light. Pray that the church of God will continue to advance all across the world. Matthew 5:16 "In the same way, let your light shine before others, that they may see your good deeds and glorify your Father in heaven."
4. Pray that God will raise up strong and courageous leaders of faith in this generation. Pray that God will raise people like Jeremiah, Joshua's, Daniel's Esther's, Deborah's, etc, in the body of Christ. Jeremiah 1:17-18" "Get yourself ready! Stand up and say to them whatever I command you. Do not be terrified by them, or I will terrify you before them. 18 Today I have made you a fortified city, an iron pillar and a bronze wall to stand against the whole land—against the kings of Judah, its officials, its priests and the people of the land."
5. Pray that God will grant believers everywhere boldness to proclaim the good news of the gospel and make disciples of all nations. Matthew 28:19-20 "Then Jesus came to them and said, "All authority in heaven and on earth has been given to me. 19 Therefore go and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit, 20 and teaching them to obey everything I have commanded you. And surely, I am with you always, to the very end of the age."
